ORDER

The system of generation of online WQSC (Weight, Quality & Stock Certificate) against receipt

of CMR was started vide Order No. 142-SS/FS/O/Sectt./IT-10/2013 dated 07.04.2016. In this module,

the Godown Inspectors are required to generate WQSC against receipt of FAQ rice(CMR) by Online

Inventory Management System against each truck / consignment of rice. The District Controller, F&S,

were required to sign in each copies of WQSC vide Order No. 186-SS/FS/O/SECTT/IT-10/2013 dated 5th

July'2017. It requires huge paper works and time in compiling the CMR delivery in a particular district.

To overcome the constraints, a single Consolidated WQSC module has been developed by

combining all individual WQSCs against a single Delivery Order of CMR. Now therefore in partial

modification of aforesaid orders, the implementation of the inventory management software will be in

operation from this KMS 2019-20, following the procedures described below:-

a) The Delivery Order or the D.O., for delivery of CMR will now be referred as "Rice Received

Order(R.R.O.)", henceforth.

b) The R.R.O. shall be generated by the DCF&Ss, in online module, using their individual login id,

against the offer, as submitted by the Rice Mills / CMR Agencies. The CMR Agencies / Rice

Millers(for CPC purchase) shall be asked to submit the offer after custom milling of paddy, using

the online module.

c) The Godown Inspector-in-charge shall download the R.R.O., from online module or put down

the system generated R.R.O. number in their individual User ID & Password. They shall generate

online WQSC, against receipt of CMR for individual truck / consignment of Rice as it is in vogue

now.

d) After completion of the total quantum of the R.R.O., the Consolidated WQSC shall be generated

against one R.R.O.

e) This Consolidated WQSC Statement shall be signed by the Inspector / Godown-in-charge and the

Inspector(QC), both, followed by the SCF&S/ADCF&S/DCF&S.

f) The Original copy of the Consolidated WQSC Statement shall be submitted to the end of the

DCF&S only. The duplicate or triplicate, if required, may be generated online and shall be

marked as "Duplicate / Triplicate Copy". All copies shall be signed in blue / green color only.

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- g) The Office of the DCF&S shall maintain a R.R.O. register, with specific entries of the Rice Mill, CMR Agency along with one Consolidated WQSC Statement Register for individual Rice Mill / CMR Agencies.
- h) The Consolidated WQSC Statement may be furnished in the online module also in individual login id of the DCF&Ss, which will help in monitoring of delivery of CMR.
